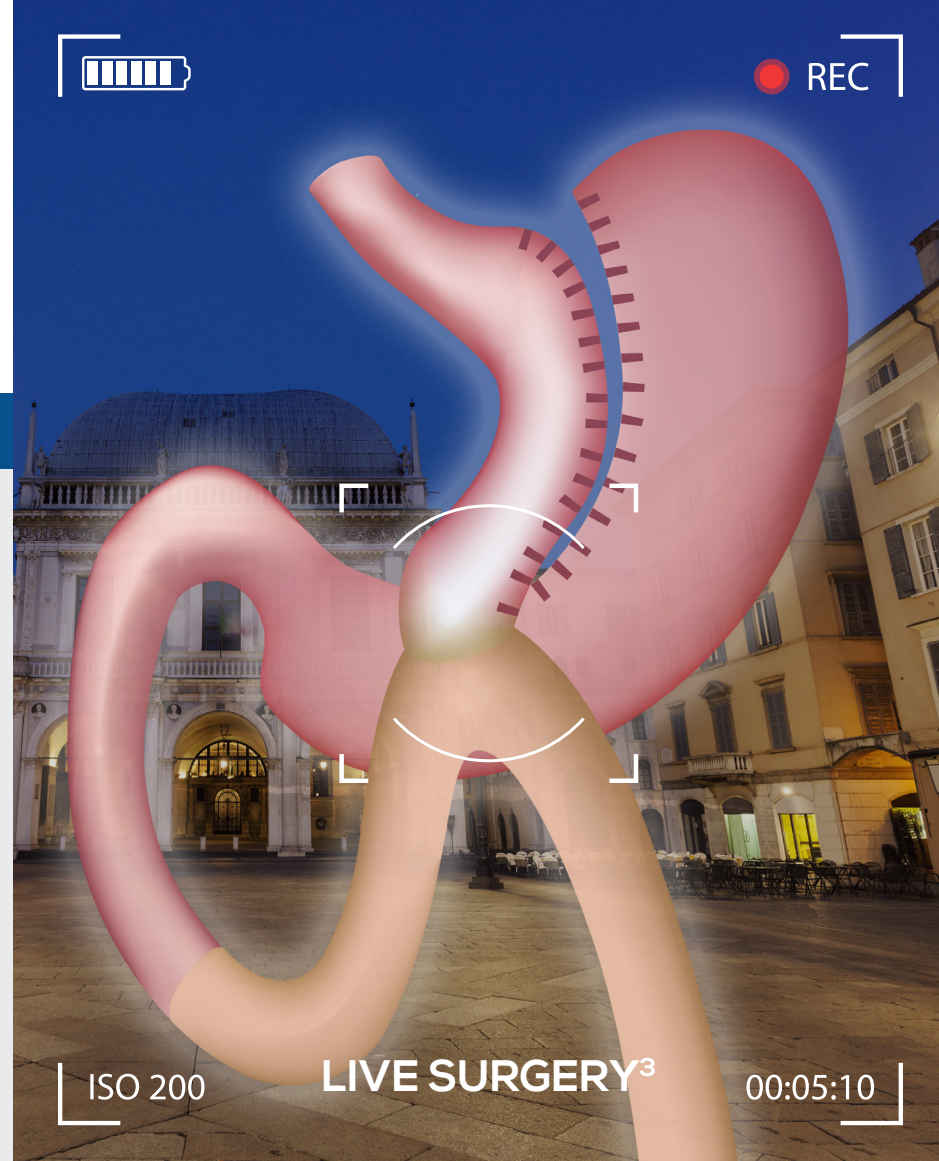

Dear Colleague,

The history of bariatric surgery has seen a cyclical alternation between malabsorptive and restrictive procedures. The introduction of the mini gastric bypass procedure in Italy as an alternative to the standard bypass procedure dates back to 2005. It became immediately evident that this technique was not just a simple technical variant of the traditional bypass, but rather a really "mixed" procedure, that combined restriction and malabsorption in a new, simple and effective way. It disproved some of the existing dogmas and therefore aroused a new interest, together, inevitably, with numerous criticisms. In recent years working together with our distinguished European colleagues we popularize in Italy and all over the world this technique and finally the mini-gastric bypass turned out to be a powerful and low-risk technique for the treatment of severe obesity. Today we want to celebrate the final acceptance and recognition of this surgical procedure with two distinguished surgeons. They have been among the few supporters and friends of the MGB and we have been collaborating in last years with the goal of seeking the best for our patients.

This is the one among three appointments...first in Brescia, then in Lisbon and London!
